



Our Response to COVID-19 – Updated 5/20/2020

**If sick or showing symptoms, been exposed to COVID-19, or coming from a hot spot of outbreak, PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE CAMPGROUND**

We are able to open for overnight stays starting Friday, May 22nd. Please review the following regarding our opening and procedures;

- We will be open Friday, May 22nd for Maine state residents only
- Beginning June 1st we will be open for Maine state residents and out-of-state residents who have completed quarantine guidelines as mandated by the State of Maine and the Maine CDC

**The following are guidelines for operations from May 22nd – June 1st which will be very limited on our facilities and functions;**

- Due to the short notice and the guidelines for opening that were given to us by the state, facilities will be closed and events cancelled
- We will be doing **Online Check In** only
- **Payment is required in full at time of reservation**
- Waivers must be sign electronically, and if bringing pets, please send a copy of rabies to [reservations@loonshaven.com](mailto:reservations@loonshaven.com)
- **Wood, Ice, propane tanks (new and exchange) as well as novelty items are available for you to purchase online at [www.loonshavenfamilycampground.com](http://www.loonshavenfamilycampground.com) Under Camping Services for delivery to your site during normal business hours (8am-5pm)**
- Gatherings of more than 10 are not allowed.
- Patrons should wear face coverings in public areas whenever physical distancing is not possible.



- Reservations at this time are restricted to Maine residents
- Boat and Fishing Docks will remain open with social distancing practices; keep 6' apart.
- No visitors to the campground. Please limit the amount of people that are in your camper to your household.
- No facilities will be open except for the Laundromat, which will have no more than 1 person in at a time inside.
  - Store, Café, Playground, Basketball Court, Horseshoe Pit, Bathhouses, and Rec Hall will all be closed until at least June 1st.
  - Swimming in the pond is allowed. Maintain physical distancing in the presence of other non-family patrons on beach areas and limit your time on the beach to allow others to enjoy it. Practice social distancing on the beach and in the water.

#### **After June 1st;**

- Reservations for Maine state residents and out-of-state residents who have completed quarantine guidelines as mandated by the State of Maine and the Maine CDC
- We will be doing **Online Check In** only
- Waivers must be sign electronically, and if bringing pets, please send a copy of rabies to [reservations@loonshaven.com](mailto:reservations@loonshaven.com)
- **Wood, Ice, propane tanks (new and exchange) as well as novelty items are available for you to purchase online at [www.loonshavenfamilycampground.com](http://www.loonshavenfamilycampground.com) Under Camping Services for delivery to your site during normal business hours (8am-5pm)**
- Gatherings of more than 50 are not allowed.
- Patrons should wear face coverings in public areas whenever physical distancing is not possible.
- Boat and Fishing Docks will remain open with social distancing practices; keep 6' apart.



- Visitors will be allowed. Guest visitation restricted to Maine residents and out of state visitors who have met the 14-day quarantine requirement at this time per executive order. Visitors will have to pay and sign release waivers online only.
- Basketball Court, Horseshoe Pit, Bathhouses, Rec Hall, and Laundromat will be open with restrictions on amount of people to comply with social distancing.
- The Playground will remain **CLOSED** at this time. Further notice of when playgrounds may open will come from the State of Maine sometime in June.
- Swimming in the pond is allowed. Maintain physical distancing in the presence of other non-family patrons on beach areas and limit your time on the beach to allow others to enjoy it. Practice social distancing on the beach and in the water.
